The Public Safety Working Group is a joint working group which was established in 2014 by the Electricity Networks Association (ENA) and the Electricity Engineers Association (EEA).

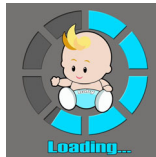

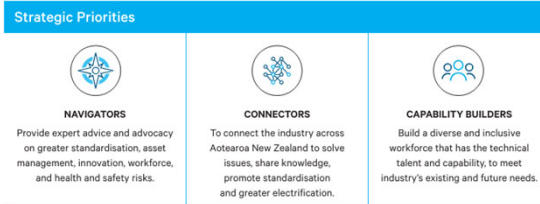


Focus:

PSWG Focus:

We have refocused our efforts on the following two items:

- Consistent Datasets – Aligned with PS Data & Collection **NAVIGATORS**
- Comms & Engagement with EDBs & Wider stakeholders **CONNECTORS**



Consistent Datasets

- Consistency across the industry in Public Safety data reporting
- WorkSafe / Energy Safety expectations – what reporting is required?
- EEA Masterclass / Teams call with YOU – August
- Reach out to Marty, Keith, Ian, Ryan or Craig
- Meaningful indicators
 - LAGGING – recording type of hits e.g., o/h line; u/g cable; poles; etc. Provides evidence needed for the likes of Look Up and Live. Also link events to critical risks.
 - LEADING – again, meaningful. How much activity linked to CR's? Key findings e.g. 3rd parties breaching MADs – data for regulators and law makers to drive safety improvements.
